—Notice about Alternative Achievement Test Changes for the 2017 Entrance Examination—

8 September, 2015

The Shizuoka University Asia Bridge Program (ABP) is holding an Alternative Achievement Test, as a part of the 2015 and 2016 academic years entrance examinations held at local test sites, for applicants who do not fulfill the ABP score requirements in the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU), the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT), or the English language tests.

However, beginning with the 2017 academic year entrance examination, the Shizuoka University ABP will no longer conduct the Alternative Achievement Test.

All applicants must take the EJU, the JLPT, and one of the English language tests, and meet the score requirements by the time of application. For details, please see the Application Guidelines for the 2017 academic year entrance examination, which are subsequently to be published.

- 2015 (1st Session): June 2015 (completed)
- 2015 (2nd Session): November 2015 (scheduled)
- 2016 (1st Session): June 2016 (scheduled)
- 2016 (2nd Session): November 2016 (scheduled)

(2) JLPT

- 2015 (1st Session): July 2015 (completed)
- 2015 (2nd Session): December 2015 (scheduled)
- 2016 (1st Session): July 2016 (scheduled)

(3) English language tests

Choose one among TOEFL-PBT, TOEFL-iBT, TOEIC, and IELTS. (Must have been taken within the two years prior to the application deadline listed in the Application Guidelines for the 2017 academic year entrance examination.)
